


Philosophy

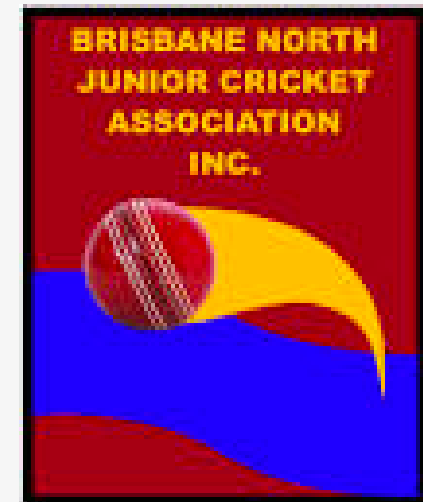
BNJCA website is not operational. Key policies they have asked us to share with you include:

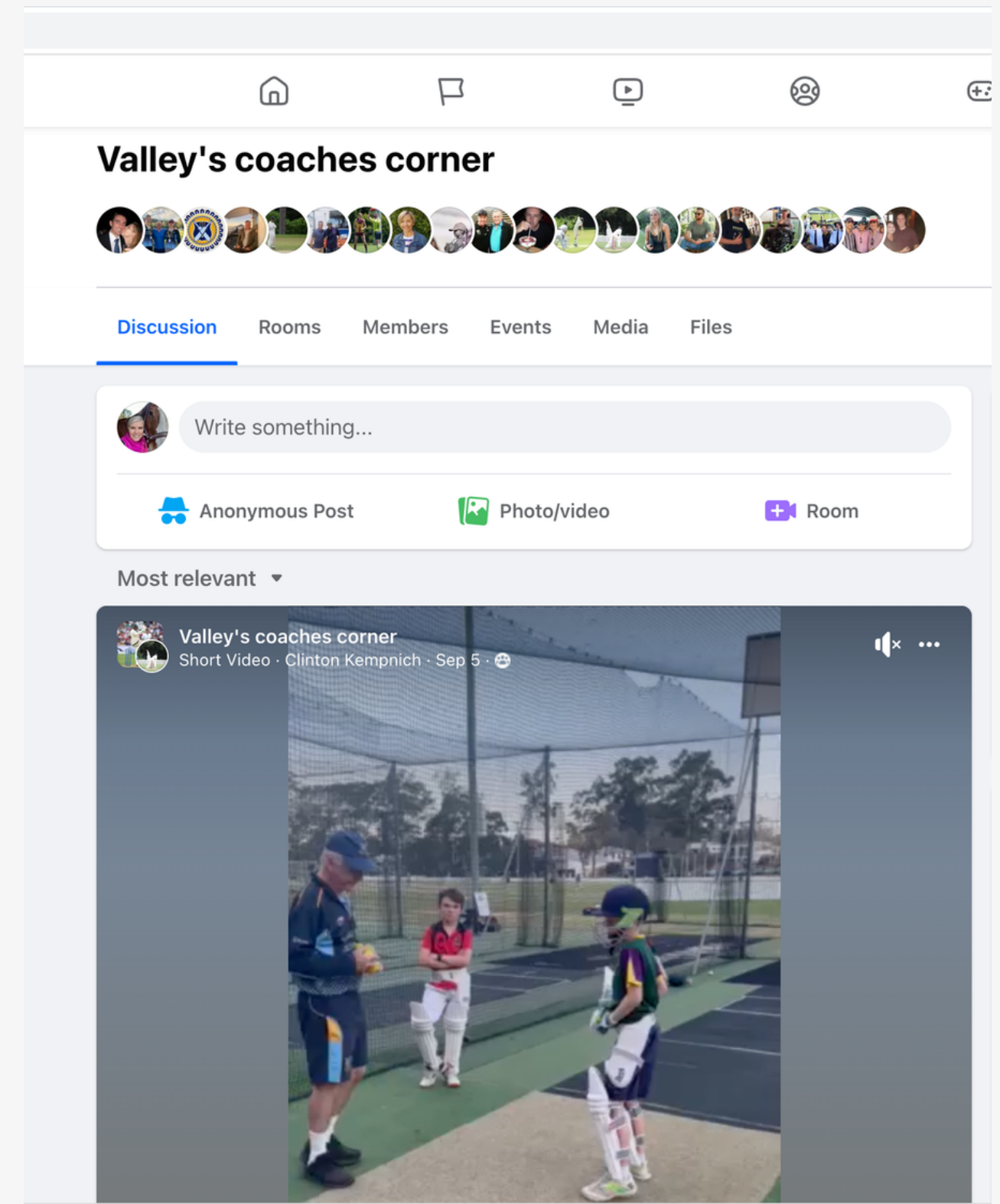

Fields and venues

- School fields typically do not have toilet access on weekends - check location of nearest park, shopping centre, fast food outlet
- No dogs permitted on school grounds - leave pooch at home please.
- Take all rubbish with you - leave the grounds how you found them
- Mitchelton State High School - collect keys from Keith Dudgeon Cricket Specialists on a Friday and return following Monday
- VDCC maintains the following fields:
 - Wittonga Park, Curramulling Park, Bowman Park, Jubilee Park, Corbie Park, Bancroft Park, Mitchelton Pony Club
- Any issues re condition of these fields/pitches can be sent to age coordinator or p.surtees@valleycricket.org.au
- If playing at VDCC **you must vacate the fields by 11.30am** for seniors games to prepare/commence. This is **not** negotiable This may be earlier if a two day match is impacted by rain.

Game Day

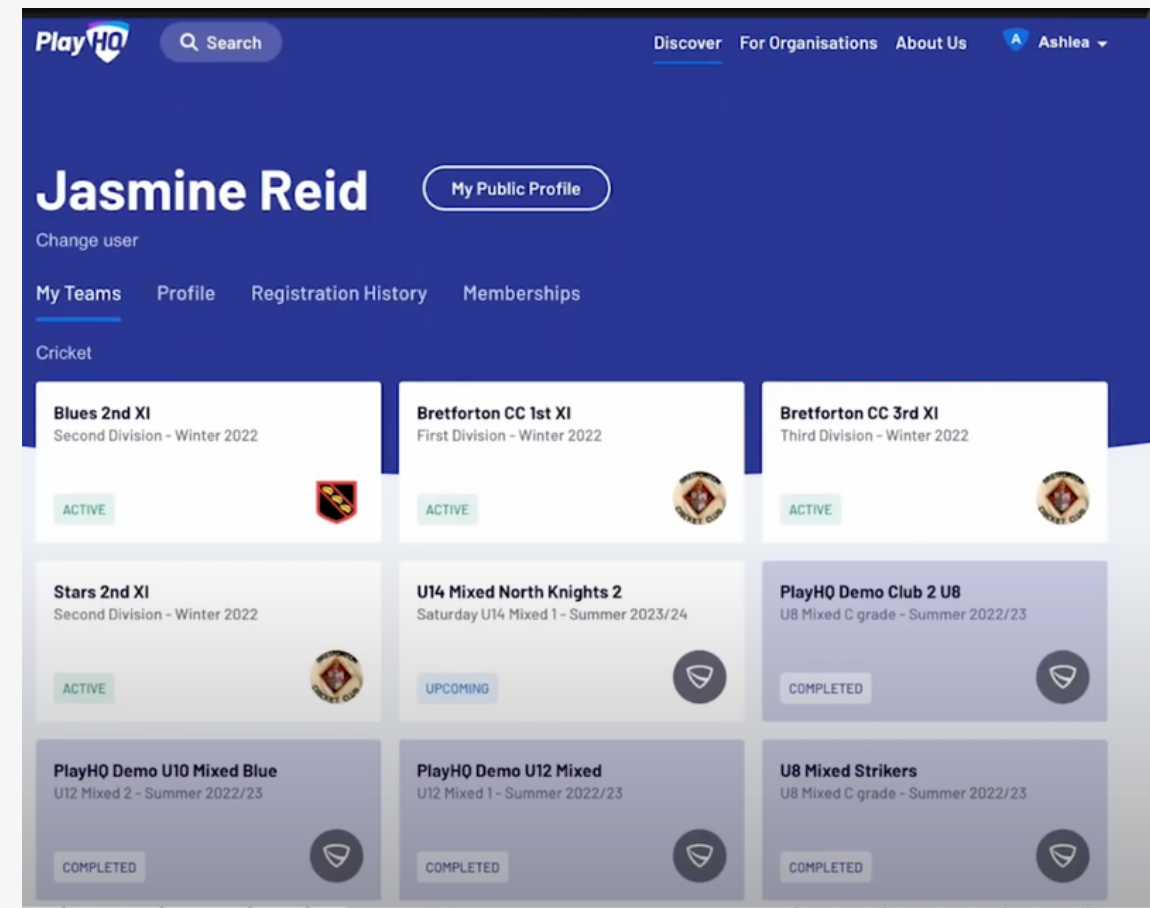
- **Start your game on time!** Very often there will be games scheduled after you, on the field you are at.
- If you're ready to start early, then start. No need to wait for the official start time.
- Things to consider to ensure your game ends on time:
 - Make sure batters are padded up ready to go. Ask parents to keep kids on task
 - Where possible have wicket keeper change overs at drinks breaks.
 - Encourage the kids to have reasonable run ups (no running in from the boundary)
 - Discourage minor field adjustments in between deliveries, particularly those made by the kids
- Check scores (online or scorebook) match your opposition - this will save angst later
- Wet weather - liaise with the opposition coach/manager. Listing of other clubs coach and mgr details will be sent to you

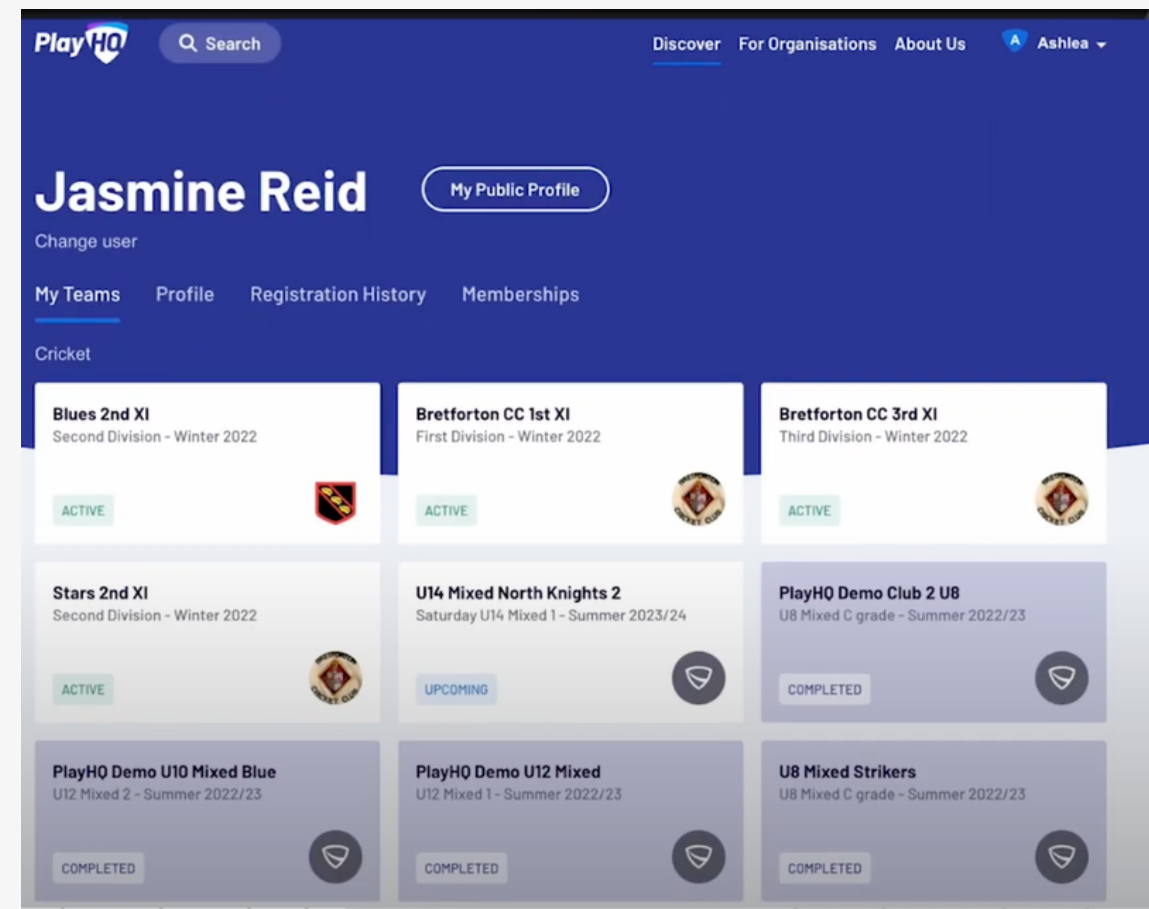
