Our Program

Our program kicked off in 2020 with the goal of providing a safe and inclusive cricket program for children and young adults with an intellectual disability. Our program is the only cricket program affiliated with Special Olympics Queensland and only one of a handful being run across South East Queensland.

The program focuses on providing a variety of skill based activities which are modified based on the participants ability level. This is facilitated by Special Olympics certified coaches working in small groups with the focus offering a fun cricket experience in a safe and inclusive space.

Our Friday afternoon program has now been expanded, with a pilot training program trialled last season, aimed at a structured skills program for those older athletes looking to enter Special Olympics and Old Cricket Inclusion pathways. We are pleased to say that Old Cricket have already identified and invited 2 athletes to trial for this coming seasons Old Cricket Inclusion Championships!

Both programs are offered **free of charge to participants.** All expenses for us to run this program are generously covered by grants and sponsorships.

Program Objectives

The Valley District Cricket Club All Abilities Program has three key objectives:

Sports Engagement: The All Abilities program is designed to bring the joy of cricket to children with intellectual disabilities. Through adapted rules and modified equipment, we provide an accessible platform for them to engage in physical activity, be part of a team, and experience the thrill of the game.

Inclusivity and Belonging: The program fosters a sense of belonging by creating an environment where these children can showcase their abilities, make new friends, and build relationships with peers who share their interests.

Emotional Development: Beyond cricket skills, the program focuses on nurturing emotional well-being, and social skills that contribute to the participant's overall development. For children with intellectual disabilities, participating in physical activities like cricket can provide an outlet for self-expression, emotional release, and the development of a more positive self-image.

how hard it can be to find sporting activities that are truly inclusive. All children deserve to be able to participate in sport in an inclusive, fun and safe environment.

Our program at Valleys was developed to give children and young adults the opportunity to participate in cricket in whatever way they feel comfortable. Some children love coming to our program because they have built friendships with our coaches. Some children have come with a level of social anxiety, and have now progressed onto our traditional junior programs. Some are now looking toward playing competition cricket via the Special Olympics pathways.

Our program is not prescriptive. All of the activities have been developed to allow the participants to participate and progress based on their individual needs. We want the children to build a level of trust and comfort in us, and their surroundings, and to find their way in their own time.
