



Men's Cricket Selection Policy

1. Team Selection:

- The First Grade coach and captain, in consultation with the Second Grade captain, will select the First and Second Grade teams.
- The First Grade and Second Grade administrator, Mitchell Pickford, will process and communicate these selections.
- The completed team lists will then be passed to the lower grade administrator, Mark Small, who will coordinate the selection of Third Grade, Fourth Grade, Fifth Grade, two Sixth Grades, and Subdistrict teams with the relevant captains.

2. Captains' Roles:

- Each captain is responsible for selecting their respective teams up to the Third Grade level.
- Captains will be involved in the selection process until the team for the grade immediately below them is finalized.
- For teams from Third Grade to Subdistricts, captains will make the final selections.

3. Administrator's Role:

- Administrators will offer input on team balance, player roles, availability, and resolve any deadlock situations.
- The completed team lists, including preselected shadow replacement players for potential representative commitments, will be finalized by Wednesday evening.

4. Communication:

- The finalized team lists will be sent to the Club Secretary and announced via all club social media platforms.
- Any subsequent changes will be directed to both administrators and then communicated to the Club Secretary.

5. Player Adjustments:

Players may be promoted or demoted based on performance, availability, role opportunities, development, higher grade availability, team balance, and attitude.



Conflict of Interest:

- If captains or selectors have a conflict of interest regarding a particular selection, vice captains will make the final decision.
- Captains with a conflict of interest must leave the selection meeting during the discussion of the affected selection.
