Abercrombie Charles Stuart VDCC Career 1902/03 to 1903/04

Born: 26 October 1878 in Albury, NSW Died: 10 September 1954 in Brisbane

He departed Pinkenba on the transport Duke of Portland on the 1 Mar 1900, calling at Albany on the 12 Mar 1900 and arrived at Cape Town on 2 Apr 1900. The contingent then proceeded to Beira and disembarked there.

He took part operations in Rhodesia, Transvaal, Orange Free State and Cape Colony.

He was appointed to rank of Lieutenant (Quartermaster) on 1 Jul 1900, (Vice Lt Fielden)

He was offered a commission in the Imperial Army, but declined to leave the Contingent.

He departed Cape Town on the transport Morayshire on the 9 May 1901 and called at Freemantle, Adelaide, Melbourne and Sydney, arriving on the 7 Jun 1901. The contingent then continued by rail to Brisbane.

The unit was disbanded on the 21 Jun 1901.

He qualified for the Queens South Africa Medal with the Relief of Mafeking clasp.

273, Private, 4th Queensland Imperial Bushmen in th Boer War. He departed Pinkenba on the 18 May 1900 on the ss Manchester Port and arrived at Beira on the 14 Jun 1900. Proceeded to Port Elizabeth (20 Jun 1900) and then sent to Cape Town and disembarked on the 23 Jun 1900. He was promoted to Corporal on 1 Jun 1900. P. L. Murray shows he was promoted to Quarter Master Sergeant on 6 Apr 1901 however this rank is not shown on the pay sheets. He was discharged in South Africa and returned to England.

WWI

At the outbreak of World War 1 he again enlisted. Six weeks before the armistice of 1918 whilst on active duty with the Royal Scots Fusiliers he was killed and is buried at Karasouli Cemetery.

In World War 1 he was with the 3rd Machine Gun Battalion and served in France.

Alroe Leslie Gladstone VDCC Career 1911/12 to 1913/14

In World War 1 he was a Staff Sergeant in the 1st Australian Light Horse Brigade. He enlisted on 21 August 1914; and at the conclusion of the war Returned to Australia, 21 January 1919.

On his return to Australia in 1941, he served in various Ordinance roles culminating in the command of Colmslie Ordinance Depot with the rank of Major.

In World War 2 he was a gunner with the 5th Australian Field Regiment.

Queensland's first known war memorial pays tribute to a young school teacher, Lt John (Jack) Lachlan Caskey who left with the Fifth Contingent to fight in the Boer War in South Africa, but was killed in action at Mokari Drift on 27 September 1901. Fellow teachers erected a plaque, which is now in the care of the Clifton Returned Services League (Toowoomba region). A special plaque is also displayed at Allora State School (Warwick region), so this exceptional young Australian teacher is honoured with three personal memorials.
